<b>Ephesus</b> <b>2:1-7</b> The Loveless Church	He who holds the seven stars in His right hand and walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands. <b>Smyrna</b> <b>2:8-11</b> The Persecuted Church	The First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life.	Endured their tribulation and poverty. Also recognized the blasphemies of the Synagogue of Satan.	NA	Do not fear the things they were about to Suffer, but be faithful unto death.	NA	The Crown of Life, and not being hurt by the second death.
<b>Pergamos</b> <b>2:12-17</b> The Compromising Church	He who has the sharp two-edged sword.	Held fast to His name and didn't deny His faith amid living in Satan's dwelling place.	Tolerated the false doctrine of Balaam and the Nicolaitans.	Repent.	He would come quickly and fight against them with the Sword of His Mouth.	Give some of the Hidden Manna to Eat and a white stone. On the stone, a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it.
<b>Thyatira</b> <b>2:18-29</b> The Corrupt Church	The Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass. Also, He who searches the minds and the hearts.	Increased in Good works, loved and served well, and were patient.	Allowed one to teach and seduce the church—thus corrupt leadership.	Those seduced by her doctrine, repent. Hold Fast to what they had till He comes.	He would cast her into a sickbed and those who commit adultery with her. Would kill her children with death. Would give each one according to their works.	Give Power over the Nations like He possesses and giving the morning star.
<b>Sardis</b> <b>3:1-6</b> The Dead Church	He who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars.	Had a good reputation and a few who had not defiled their garments.	They were dead and possessed imperfect works.	Be watchful, strengthen the things they still had. Remember the things they had received and heard. Hold Fast to them and repent.	He would come upon them as a thief, not knowing the hour.	Clothed in White Garments, Names not blotted out from the Book of Life, and He will confess their names before His Father and the angels.
<b>Philadelphia</b> <b>3:7-13</b> The Faithful Church	He who is holy and true. He who has the Key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens.	Kept His Word, did not deny His name, Kept His commandment to Persevere.	NA	Hold Fast what they had.	NA	Set before them an open door that no one can shut. Making those of the synagogue of Satan come and worship at their feet. Kept from the hour of trial which shall come on the whole world. Make them a pillar in the temple of His God and they shall go out no more. Write on them the name of His God and the name of the city of His God, the New Jerusalem. And write on them His new name.
<b>Laodicea</b> <b>3:14-22</b> The Lukewarm Church	The Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the Creation of God.	NA	Were Lukewarm, thinking they were rich, wealthy and in need of nothing, but were really wretched, miserable, poor, blind and naked.	Buy from Him gold refined in the fire and white garments and anoint their eyes with eye salve. Be zealous and repent. Hear His voice and open the door.	Would be vomited out of His Mouth, the shame of their nakedness would be revealed.	He will come in and dine with them. Grant to sit with Him on His throne as He overcame and sat down on His Father's throne.
